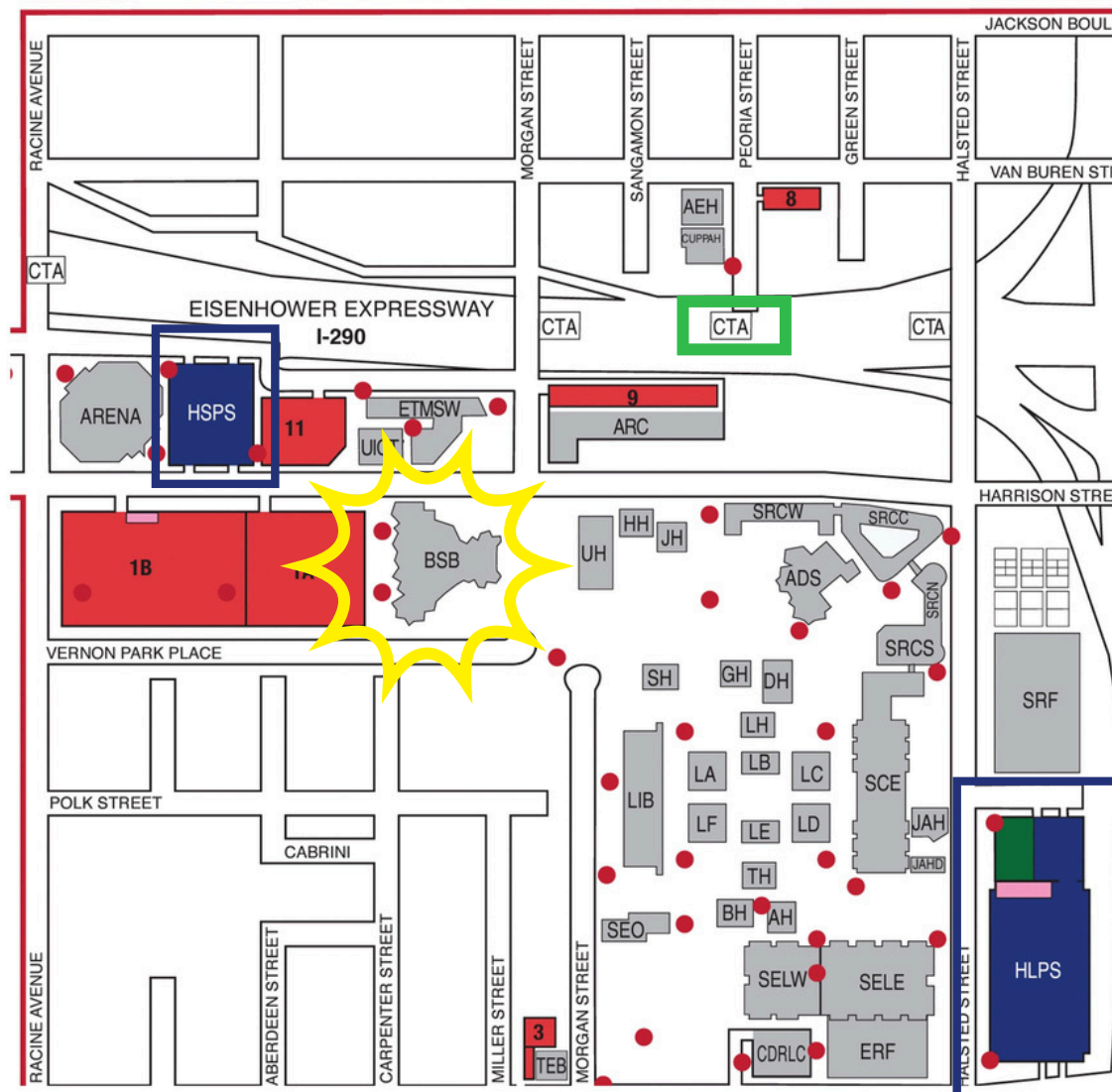


HOW TO FIND US

The University of Illinois Chicago is located southwest of the intersection of the Kennedy Expressway and Eisenhower Expressway

The **Institute for the Humanities** is in the **Behavioral Sciences Building (BSB)** and marked in **yellow** on the map below. The Institute is located on the first floor of the BSB (1007 W. Harrison St/Morgan). Our phone number is 312-996-6354.

Parking is available in the lots labeled **HSPS** and **HLPS**. Parking locations are marked in **blue**. The CTA stop (UIC-Halsted on the Blue Line) is marked in **green**.



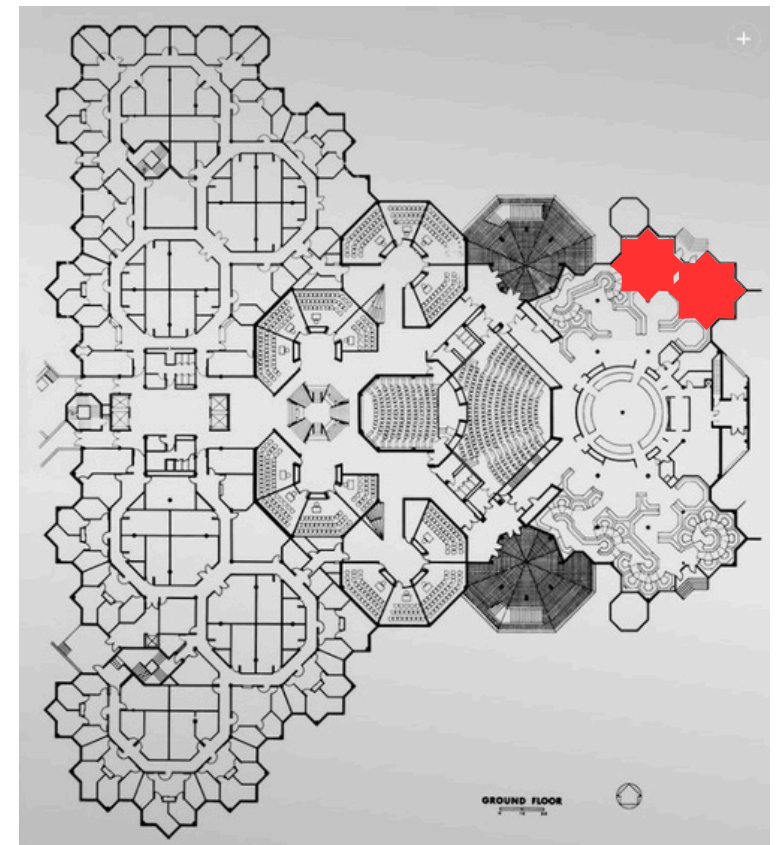
The Behavioral Sciences Building is a Hive.

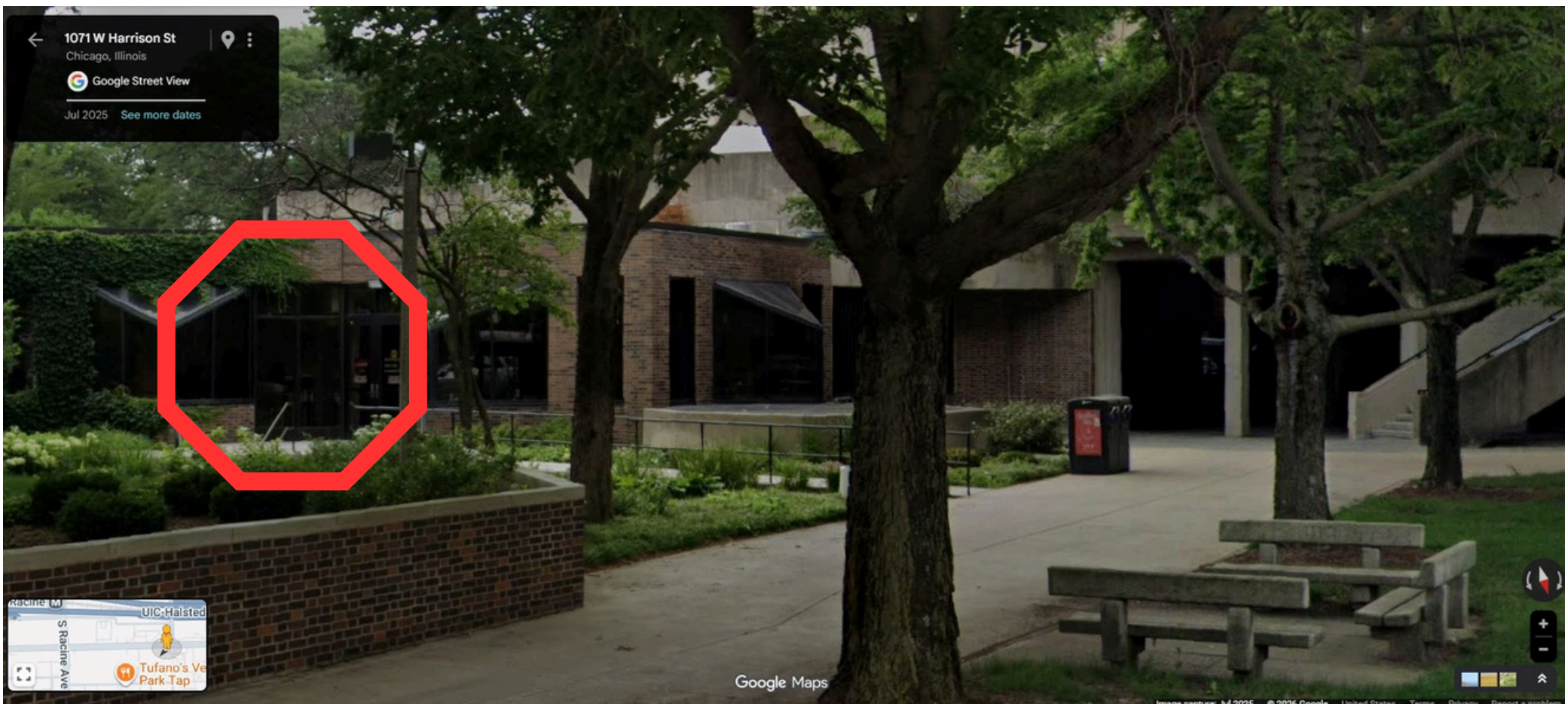
The simplest way to enter the Institute for the Humanities is through the **exterior entrance on the northeastern corner of the building**, which leads directly into the lecture space.

Important: The Behavioral Sciences Building has **two entrances on the northeastern corner**. Please use the Institute for the Humanities entrance.

The Institute for the Humanities entrance is a **glass door set into a vine-covered brick wall**, with angular windows jutting out beside it. The door faces an open, sunken concrete area.

Do not enter through the main BSB entrance, which is located next to outdoor stairs and underneath a concrete balcony/overhang.
